

Town Center Area Community Improvement District Project Updates

Project Name: Noonday Creek Multi-Use Trail

Project Description:

The Noonday Creek Multi-Use Trail is a 6 mile continuation of the Mountain to River trail that currently ends at Kennesaw Mountain National Battlefield Park.

The Town Center Area CID is the lead agency responsible for developing this project that will extend through the Town Center Area CID to Bells Ferry Road.

The TCACID provided PE with design for Phase 1A and 1B that picks up at the Park's Visitor's Center and extends to Barrett Parkway. The National Park Service and Cobb County will oversee the construction of Phase 1A and 1B.

The TCACID will pay for the construction of Phase 2B and Cobb County will pay for Right-of-Way for this section of the trail beginning at Cobb Parkway and Noonday Creek. Phase 2C begins at Barrett Lakes and continues to Bells Ferry Road and should be constructed in mid 2010.

Phase 2B will be a paved multi-purpose trail facility between 8' and 12' in width that will run along portions of Noonday Creek, Vaughn Road, Cobb Place Blvd. and Barrett Lakes Blvd.
